

## Call for Creative Teaching Facilitators!

The Arts Collab seeks engaging and creative educators to become Creative Teaching Facilitators! Candidates with several years of formal education experience who have passion for leading other educators in developing their creativity and have flexibility a few times a year to lead sessions at any school in the Greater Birmingham area are especially encouraged to apply. Facilitators will be trained by Arts Collab consultants on Creative Teaching strategies and deliver Creative Teaching professional development to educators across our area on an as-called basis. Several qualified candidates may be selected.

Excellent candidates include:

- Educators with at least 5 years of teaching experience and/or teaching artists with more than 5 years of experience who thoroughly understand the public-school teaching environment and can anticipate teacher needs. Educators of any specialty and grade-level are eligible; candidates do not need to have an arts-specialty and do not currently need to be actively teaching.
- Have a deep passion for creativity-based teaching methodologies and innovating the classroom setting.
- Enjoy supporting and leading other educators in thinking differently about their teaching practice.
- Have flexibility in their schedule to work on an as-called basis a few times a year at any school within Jefferson County, Alabama.
- Are comfortable receiving facilitator training and then delivering material from the training to other teachers.
- Are available on July 11-12, 2024 from 9am-5pm to receive Creative Teaching Facilitator training at our office (811 5<sup>th</sup> Ave N, Birmingham), as well as continued training approximately once per semester up to a few years. Availability for these dates is required for consideration. Please don't apply if you're unavailable on July 11-12.

### Working Conditions

Contract work per session in a school setting and during school hours or afterschool based on availability. Paid training sessions at \$175 per day plus meals. Leading Professional development compensated at \$350 per day or \$200 per half day. The Arts Collab will contact facilitators as opportunities to lead professional development become available. New hires will undergo training to use licensed materials necessary for their roles. Hiring contingent upon full in-person attendance for training session and signed agreement of understanding that the licensed materials are restricted for use solely within the scope of the Arts Collab within the Greater Birmingham area.
